








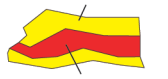

### Flood evacuation announcements

<b>① Prepare to evacuate notice</b>	Be prepared to evacuate at any time.
<b>② Evacuation warning</b>	Begin evacuation according to instructions.
<b>③ Evacuation order</b>	Evacuate immediately.

### Instructions for walking/wading during a flood



The walkable depth of water is 70cm for men and 50cm for women. Do not attempt to walk through water at waist level or above. Await rescue on high ground.



Use a long stick to check for hidden dangers in your path as you walk.



Do not go barefoot or wear long boots. Lace-up sports shoes are best.



To avoid separation, evacuees should use a rope to connect themselves to each other before evacuation. Never let children out of your sight.



When necessary, carry the elderly and those who need assistance on your back. Use any floats (inner tube, life jacket) to make sure young children are safe.
